

PRESEASON CHECKLIST

OYSA Registration & Background Check

Make sure this is completed ASAP. It can take up to 2 weeks to complete. You will not be able to start practices until this is complete. Applies for assistant and team parent as well.

Identify an Assistant

Our club requires that every team have an OYSA approved (background+SafeSport) assistant or team parent to assist the head coach. Look for this person early!

Contact all Families

Please look for an email from PlayMetrics. This is our club communication platform and how you will connect with individual families about your first practice, game schedule, changes, etc.

SafeSport Training

SafeSport is an educational program designed to keep all our players safe. It is required by OYSA and it must be completed by any adult engaging with players during practice or games.

Pick up Gear

Stay tuned for information about gear pick up! We will supply balls, cones, pinnies, first aid supplies, and any other items you need.

Coaches Cards

All coaches are required to have a coaches card on hand at games. Upload a photo to Affinity to ensure you will be issued a card.

- Set up an environment that is safe and fun.
- Activities that allow players to warm up and have fun e.g. Sharks and Minnows and Red Light Green Light

PRACTICE


- Focus on targeted learning activities like dribbling, passing, and finishing
- Remember, no lines!

PHILOSOPHY

Coaches should focus on making soccer fun! We aren't keeping score and success is measured in smiles and laughs. We emphasize equal playing time and want to get players as many touches on the ball as possible.

PLAY

 The goal is to allow for play that is uninterrupted and allows the coach to assess learning during the session e.g. scrimmage

SOCCER 5 RULES



- NO extra time
- NO slide tackling
- Offside rule enforced
- If a team is down by 5 they can add a player



Coaches Cards

- Required for all adults on sidelines with players
- Can be a photo of your card saved on your phone
- As a coach you can proactively offer your card to the referee
- If an adult does not have a card they will be asked to join the parents as a spectator

GAME DAY!

What you need to know!



Home Field Set Up

1st game of the day is responsible for field set up. Equipment in field box (code 3831).

- Unlock the porta potty (code 3831)
- Set up goals, make sure to add weights
- Set up flags at the corners

Home Field Take Down

Last game of the day is responsible for field take down.

- Lock the porta potty
- Put goals and flags back in box and lock
- Roll goals together

Arrive to Games 30min Early

Allows time for set up and warm up for players

- Field locations can be found on our website nesoccerclub.com
- Check field policy regarding dogs prior to game (OC and Molalla have strict rules)

SOCCER 5 HIGHLIGHTS

NO JEWELRY of any kind is allowed. This includes especially earrings, nose studs, rings, and necklaces. TAPING over earrings is not allowed. This is strictly enforced in US Soccer.

If a team is ahead by **five**goals, the opposing team can
add a player if they wish. If a
team is ahead by eight goals, a
second player can be added.
Remove the extra players as the
goal spread diminishes.

ALL Spectators are to be on the sideline **OPPOSITE** of the teams.

Coaches & players will remain on their own half of the side they are on. Neither coaches nor parents are allowed behind the goal.

Only club registered coaches who have completed all requirements may be on the sidelines with the team.

Coaches will be asked to show their **coach's card** at check-in.

For **substitutions**, players must enter the field of play at the **midfield** on the team's side of the field. When your subs are ready, tell them to wait at the centerline. Wait for the referee to signal the subs onto the field.

Coaches must stay near the bench.

Avoid loitering in the centerline area—keep that for subs, and do move down the line to the other half. Once the game begins, do not enter the field unless beckoned by the referee.
