# MINI COACHING RULES



## 1 NO Laps!

Never use running laps as a punishment! It's normal for kids to not listen at this age, running laps won't make a 5 year-old more attentive. It likely will just make them want to skip practice.

## 3 NO Lines!

You don't like waiting in lines. Kids don't either. Create activities that keep all feet moving instead of waiting to kick a ball.

## 5 Focus on Fun!

Our goal is to create a life long love of soccer. Kids will never remember their win/loss record but they will remember how you made them feel.

## 2 NO Lectures!

Unless you can give a compelling 30 sec lecture, skip them all together. Small children want to play. Keep your verbal direction short and focused.

## 4 NO Bad Language!

Congratulations you are now a coach and have become a role model for these players! These tiny sponges are watching everything you do. Our goal is to inspire, not teach creative language.

## 6 Come Prepared!

Trust us, life is easier if you have a plan. Spend 5-10 minutes to come up with a practice plan prior to practice.

## PRESEASON CHECKLIST

### OYSA Registration & Background Check

Make sure this is completed ASAP. It can take up to 2 weeks to complete. You will not be able to start practices until this is complete. Applies for assistant and team parent as well.

### SafeSport Training

SafeSport is an educational program designed to keep all our players safe. It is required by OYSA and it must be completed by any adult engaging with players during practice or games.

### Identify an Assistant

Our club requires that every team have an OYSA approved (background+SafeSport) assistant or team parent to assist the head coach. Look for this person early!

### Pick up Gear

Stay tuned for information about gear pick up! We will supply balls, cones, pinnies, first aid supplies, and any other items you need.

### Contact all Families

Please look for an email from PlayMetrics. This is our club communication platform and how you will connect with individual families about your first practice, game schedule, changes, etc.

### Coaches Cards

All coaches are required to have a coaches card on hand at games. Upload a photo to Affinity to ensure you will be issued a card.

## HAVE A PLAN!

### PLAY-PRACTICE-PLAY

## PLAY

- Set up an environment that is safe and fun.
- Activities that allow players to warm up and have fun e.g. Sharks and Minnows and Red Light Green Light

## PRACTICE

- Focus on targeted learning activities like dribbling, passing, and finishing
- Remember, no lines!

## PLAY

- The goal is to allow for play that is uninterrupted and allows the coach to assess learning during the session e.g. scrimmage

## PHILOSOPHY

Coaches should focus on making soccer fun! We aren't keeping score and success is measured in smiles and laughs. We emphasize equal playing time and want to get players as many touches on the ball as possible.







## Soccer 5 Kindergarten (U6) Details

<b>Format</b>	4V4 or smaller
<b>Maximum Roster</b>	6 players
<b>Keeper</b>	None
<b>Offside</b>	No
<b>Ball Size</b>	Size 3
<b>Game Time</b>	4 Quarters, 10 minutes each
<b>Break between quarters</b>	5 minutes
<b>Referees</b>	None

If a team is up by 5 the other team can add a player.

NO extra time. NO slide tackling. NO offside rule. NO direct kicks or penalty kicks; all free kicks are indirect. NO headers.

Goal kicks, corner kicks, throw-ins optional at this age.
